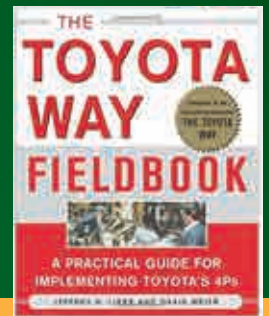

Course Overview:

Lean is a philosophy aimed at eliminating waste. Waste is all things that do not add value. Lean mostly aims at reduction of cycle time.

Successful implementation of Lean thinking improves quality, patient satisfaction, employee satisfaction and lowers cost. Lean management leads to a substantial improvement of performance.

Lean was developed by the founder of Toyota, Sakichi Toyoda, and head of engineering Taiichi Ohno. Toyota was able to improve performance in all respects through the Lean philosophy and became one of the largest and most successful companies in the world. Thanks to this big success this philosophy has been implemented by many other organizations throughout the world.

Implementing Lean management is not a very complicated technical thing. It does require profiled training and professional facilitation. In general it requires quite different thinking. And change management plays a role. For successful implementation of Lean support from management, employees and speaking the same language is of crucial importance

Who Should Attend?

This course is designed for top and middle managers and quality officers who are involved in managing organizations and therefore have an interest in improving performance.

- Department managers, Functional Managers, Divisional Managers and Business managers who are responsible for a part of the organization and see opportunities to start up new improvement projects and want to be Lean Green Belt
- Quality Managers who also see the power of Lean can be applied in their organizations and want to be Lean Green Belt



Course Content:

Day 1

- Introduction to Lean - A history of Lean and the need for change.
- Benefits: How Lean benefits organizations in terms of productivity, cash flow, speed, quality, service levels and employee involvement.
- Lean Vision: Example of a Lean vision that can be used to focus the organization on Lean Goals.
- Features of Outstanding Service Organizations
- Lean People: Characteristics of "Lean People"
- Lean Elements, Rules and Tools - A comprehensive review of core Lean concepts.
- Eliminating Waste - Detailed review of the 8 types of waste that exist in all processes and the barriers encountered when attempting to eliminate waste.
- Value - Determination of Value as the critical starting point for the Lean transformation as well as ongoing continuous incremental improvement
 - Value Defined
 - Value- External Customer
 - Value- Internal Downstream Customer
 - Value- The customer of an external supplier
- Value Stream Mapping - Understanding how to map the Value Streams for the entire Lean and how to distinguish between value added and non-value added processes. How Value Stream Mapping is used as both a strategic and planning tool.
- Root Cause Analysis - a structured approach to define root causes of problems. Unlike traditional problem solving methods Root Cause Analysis gets to the root of problems, thereby preventing organizational performance to slide back after implementation of solutions related to the roots. Root Cause Analysis is practiced and taught as a systematic tool.

Day 2

- Kaizen (Rapid Team Problem Solving) and Process Mapping-Kaizen is the engine that drives the transformation of traditional business processes to a Lean and it is the vehicle for continuous incremental improvement. Process Mapping is included in this section as it is an integral part of Kaizen.
- Visual Workplace - Explanation of the Visual Workplace, and how can it be used to enhance productivity, pursue perfection and maintain a clean and safe workplace.
- 5S (Workplace Organization) - Comprehensive review of methods used to organize the workplace and provide a clean and safe environment that results in reduced costs.
- Lean Metrics - Key metrics and methods used to report continuous incremental improvement.
- Selection and running of projects - the way you can deploy your Green belt knowledge and experience in selecting and running projects within your own working environment is practised and discussed.

CERTIFICATION:

Exam to Certify for Green belt - Participants take a one-hour exam as the basis for their Certification.
